### **Clear the Way for the Lord**

"A voice is calling, 'Clear the way for the Lord in the wilderness; make smooth in the desert a highway for our God." (Isaiah 40:3). This verse from the first reading for the Second Sunday of Advent, Dec. 8th reminds all faithful that the liturgical season leading up to Christmas is a time for preparation and purification.

Amid the many ways Catholics get ready to celebrate the birth of Jesus - gift-giving, entertaining family and friends, supporting charities the sacrament of reconciliation is often overlooked. Yet a good confession can be one of the best ways to enter into the joy of the Christmas with a clean heart, light and love.

Advent is a perfect time for reconciliation and penance because of two reasons: One, it allows us to ritually (and) sacramentally acknowledge our own incompleteness. Second, it allows God to touch us, and give us the completeness, the healing, the fullness, that only he can give. There will be a special celebration of the Sacrament of Confession on Monday 16th December at 7p.m. A number of visiting priests will attend.

You are encouraged to join in this celebration as part of our preparation for the feast of the birth of our Saviour Jesus Christ.

### **Prayer for Parents of Confirmation Children**

O Lord give us the wisdom and the courage to help our children as you would, to develop in them a Christ-like love for all people.

Creator Spirit, strengthen this child with your gifts of grace, to love and serve as a disciple of Christ. Grant that she may grow into the fullness of the stature of Christ. Fill her him with the joy of your presence. Increase in her/him the fruit of your Spirit: the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of love, patience and gentleness, the spirit of wonder and true holiness.

Guide us in our responsibilities and duties as parents; May we be the expression of Your love to our children. As we begin to prepare our children to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation, give us the wisdom to guide them, the patience to teach them, and the vigilance to accustom them to choose good through our example. We ask this through the intercession of Mary, St. Ita, and all the angels and saints. Amen.
