World Day of Remembrance for Road Traffic Victims

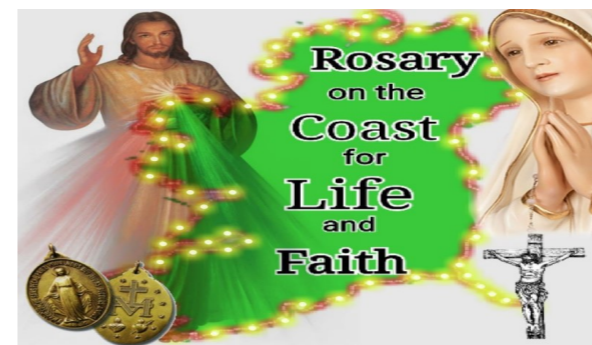
