He hopes that during the Year many will come on pilgrimage to the Cathedral and pass through that Holy Door. Let's remember, of course, that it opens both inwards and

outwards! We are called "in" to God's great mercy in order to go "out" to show mercy to the world in our day-to-day relationships with others.

The door is on the top right of the church, facing across the carpark to the presbytery.

There is a banner over it.

When people come in, there is a basket with details of what to do.

Access to the cathedral is from 9am until 6.30pm each day. Bishop Brendan invites you to go there on pilgrimage and pass through the door. May your pilgrimage to the Diocesan Holy Door be a special moment for you.
