	The two evenings of reflection in Templeglantine are open to all parishioners, so save the dates and make the For further information contact Fr Tony The Duties and Responsibilities of a Confirmation Sponsor The duties and responsibilities of a Confirmation sponsor are not just for the occasion itself, but for life. It should not be undertaken lightly and the role should be fully understood before it is accepted. If asked to be a Confirmation sponsor, take some time to think about it before accepting. You are not just agreeing to take a role at the Confirmation ceremony itself, you are agreeing to a lifetime commitment. You need to be sure that you'll be a good role model for the candidate, not just now, but in the future. You are required to maintain a relationship with the candidate once they are Confirmed and be there to offer spiritual guidance when it is needed. Sponsors have to be at least 16 years of age and need to be practicing church members them- selves. They must also have been Confirmed in order to sponsor another at Confirmation. The role of a Confirmation sponsor during the ceremony is easy. You simply place your hand on the shoulder of your candidate. The main role you provide is of a supportive presence.
