World Day of Remembrance for Road Traffic Victims

**18th Nov is World Day of Remembrance for Road
Traffic Victims** Mass will be celebrated here on Sat 17th
Nov. @ 6.30pm.

"On this 'World Remembrance Day for Road Traffic
Victims' we remember those who have died as a result of
traffic accidents on our Limerick roads and nationwide,
and the families who have been devastated by their loss.

*Lord, give to us, and to all who use the roads,
consideration and care for other road users.
Grant to those who drive vehicles consideration for
others and a determination to avoid driving in ways
which could be a danger to others. Give to those
who walk or cycle on the roads and those who play
beside them thoughtful caution and care. For those
who are travelling today, give them protection on
the way and a safe arrival at their destination".*

Over 38,500 people killed on roads on the island of
Ireland will be remembered this Sunday. Behind every
statistic are family and friends who have been affected
and we must remember them. World Day of
remembrance reminds us how easily tragedy can happen
but, by making small changes to our behaviour on the
roads, we can all help to prevent future tragedy. Slow
down, wear the seat belts, do not use the mobile phone, be
courteous on the road and eliminate high risk behaviours.
We also think of the emergency services and medical pro-
fessionals who deal with the aftermath and consequences
of collisions and pray for their
continued work at these difficult situations. *Daily papers*
