

***In Solidarity with the People of Ukraine.***

May is one of the most beautiful months of the year when all of nature so richly comes to life after winter. Now that all lockdowns have been lifted we fully appreciate more than ever the vibrancy of this month. In this time of cruel war, we know that we are privileged to have this freedom.

In Ukraine, the usual springtime activity of planting in the fields is replaced with people taking shelter from the constant bombardment. The endless shelling drowning out any song from birds or machinery busy in the fields. Pope Francis has asked us to pray the Rosary during the month of May and to pray urgently for peace. We do all that we can to support the people of Ukraine in their hour of need.

On Friday night 27<sup>th</sup> of May, a 'Concert for Peace' will be held here in the church. We are asking parishioners to 'Unite for Ukraine' by supporting this fundraising event. Tickets are on sale in nearly all shops here in the town. Tickets will also be available on the night of the Concert. This is our opportunity to stand in solidarity with the people of Ukraine. Tickets are €10. It will also be an occasion for people to come together again as we leave behind the experience of 'lockdown.'

***Charles de Foucauld***

Saint [Charles de Foucauld](#) (1858-1916) was a French soldier, explorer, geographer, Catholic priest and hermit who lived among the Tuareg people in the Sahara in Algeria. He was assassinated in 1916. His inspiration and writings led to the founding of the *Little Brothers of Jesus* among other religious congregations. Charles de Foucauld was canonised by Pope Francis on the 15<sup>th</sup> of May 2022.

His beautiful Prayer of Abandonment says it all:

*Father, I abandon myself into your hands; do with me what you will.  
 Whatever you may do, I thank you: I am ready for all, I accept all.  
 Let only your will be done in me, and in all your creatures.  
 I wish no more than this, O Lord. Into your hands I commend my soul;  
 I offer it to you with all the love of my heart, for I love you, Lord, and so need to  
 give myself, to surrender myself into your hands, without reserve,  
 and with boundless confidence, for you are my Father.*
