Do This in Memory is a parish based programme of preparation for First Communion centred in the parish celebration of the Sunday Eucharist and in the home.

It is designed to help children, parents/guardians and the wider parish community prepare for First Eucharist.

The programme resources are designed to facilitate parents/guardians, families and the parishes' active involvement in the preparation for the sacrament. It complements and supports the work of sacramental preparation in the parish school. The programme takes place once a month for eight months before First Eucharist and concludes during the parish celebration of the Feast of Corpus Christi.
