A collection will be taken up at all Masses this weekend for the missions. I should point out that the Missions collection is different to the Trocaire collection

that goes to social projects. The donations from this weekend's collections go to support churches, parishes, hospitals, schools and vocations in countries where the Church is new, young or poor. The Pontifical Missions ensures that resources are distributed equitably and justly on the basis of need. As priests who have spent time abroad in missionary territories remind us, 1000 euro would go a long way in these countries so an extra encouraging word from a priest this weekend can be significant because if we all make the effort together across the Diocese, then the Missions will benefit.

To mark Mission Sunday, RTE will broadcast television and radio Mass at 11.00am from its Donnybrook studios in Dublin. This Mass will be celebrated by Archbishop Kieran O'Reilly SMA, Archbishop of Cashel and Emly and chair of the Bishops' Council for Missions. The congregation will include missionaries, other religious and clergy, representatives of World Missions Ireland, members of the Religious Formation Ministry programme from Loreto House, Dublin, and the choir will be provided by the National Centre for Liturgy in Maynooth.
