What Pope Francis said in Croke Park

We continue our reflections on the address given by Pope Francis during the Festival of Families celebrations in Croke Park. Pope Francis refers to Father Ragheed Ganni. Frather Ganni was from Mosul, Iraq and studied in the Irish College in Rome. While a seminarian in Rome he visited Ireland and Limerick on at least two occasions. After his ordination he returned to work as a priest in Iraq. On Trinity Sunday 2007, he was murdered along with three others, including his cousin in front of his parish church in Mosul, Iraq. Some of Fr Ragheed's family spoke in Croke Park during the Festival of Families. They spoke about forgiveness.

"As a good Irish priest taught us, "the family that prays together, stays together" and radiates peace. In a special way, such a family can be a support for other families that do not live in peace. Following the death of Father Ganni, his family chose forgiveness and reconciliation over hatred and resentment. They saw, in the light of the cross, that evil can only be fought by good, and hatred overcome only by forgiveness. Almost incredibly, they were able to find peace in the love of Christ, a love that makes all things new. This evening they share that peace with us. They prayed. Praying together.

While I was listening to the choir, I saw a mother teaching her child to make the sign of the cross. Let me ask you, do you teach your children to make the sign of the cross? Yes or no? [all: yes!] Or do you teach them to make some quick wave of the hand [he gestures] that they don't even understand? It is very important that children learn as early as possible to make the sign of the cross well. It is the first "creed" that they learn, a way of saying "I believe" in the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. This evening, before going to bed, ask you, as parents: do I teach my children to make a good sign of the cross? Think about it, it is up to you!"
