Today we have road rage, air rage, wrap rage, social media rage. Our fuses are getting shorter and shorter, our skins thinner and thinner and our patience stretched beyond breaking point. There are many explanations and t heories, but they don't touch upon the heart of the matter: the human heart and our need for repentance and conversion; the fallen human condition and our tendency to justify ourselves, defend ourselves and insist upon our rights first, over and above everyone else. How do we deal with our anger? How do we control our rage? The remedy is always repentance. Anger is alleviated by the humble and necessary first step of saying 'sorry', which, for some inexplicable reason, seems to be the hardest word.
