It's been a year since the Church Web Cam in Abbeyfeale has been installed and it has surpassed all expectations as to how important a link it has become to those living abroad and to those living closer to home. It has become very obvious that there are many people both abroad and at home, who for whatever reason, are at times unable to make their way to the Church in Abbeyfeale when they would most like to but are now able to access the Webcam through the Internet and in their own way feel that they are taking part in Mass on a Sunday or other important events such as a family Christening, First Communion, Confirmation, Wedding, Funeral etc.

The following is a breakdown of just how many people are accessing the Church Webcam.

83 – The number of Countries around the world from where the Webcam has been accessed.

30,295 – The amount of times that people around the world have accessed the Webcam.

34,900 – The total amount of viewing time in hours.

Ireland tops the table with people accessing the Webcam 19,280 times.

Top 5 Countries outside of Ireland are U.K. - 6,416, U.S.A. - 2,148, Germany – 530, Australia – 390 and Poland – 371.
