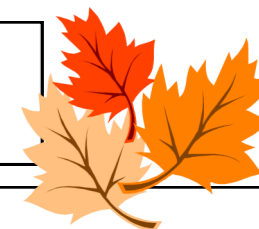

FILM: THE SIEGE OF JADOTVILLE AT GLÓRACH:

Through the very kind assistance of Helena Quinn, we look forward to
showing the film The Siege of Jadotville on Saturday evening, October
29. The siege took place during the United Nations intervention in the
Katanga conflict in the Congo in 1961, and saw a small group of Irish
peacemakers bravely holding out for as long as they could in the face of
Katangan rebels who had a vastly superior numerical advantage. Helena's
father Tadhg was a corporal in that company and we will be having a
question and answer session with Tadhg after the screening of the film. The
film has received critical acclaim, but most importantly has been given the
thumbs up from the surviving veterans of the siege. We hope to raise funds
for both the Glórach Community Theatre and also for Fr. Tim Galvin's
missionary work in Sudan, where Helena has volunteered in recent
years. Doors open at 7.30 pm and the film will begin at 8. There is a great
buzz around this so booking is essential at 0871383940 to avoid
disappointment.
