#### **Pope Francis to visit Ireland**

Welcoming the announcement Bishop Leahy said: "This is a day of great celebration for the Catholic faithful. It is almost 40 years since we had a Papal visit here and this is only the second papal visit in our history. Some 3.7million people on this island are of the Catholic faith so to have the global leader of that faith coming here is a huge moment for our nation. There are people all over Ireland today excitedly making plans to be in either Croke Park or the Phoenix Park and it is going to be a wonderful moment in all our lives".
