1 November – All Saints Day

All Saints' Day, also known as the Feast or Solemnity of All Saints, is celebrated every year on 1 November. On this day, which is a Holy Day of Obligation, we honour all of the Saints and ask them to pray for us. Mass on All Saints Day - Vigil Mass on Thurs 31st at 7.00pm. Mass on All Saints Day Fri 1st of November at 10.00am

2 November – All Souls' Day

All Souls' Day or more formally 'the Commemoration of the Faithful Departed' is a solemn celebration commemorating all of those who have died and is observed on Saturday 2 November. Mass on All Souls Day at 11.00am and 6.30pm.

An indulgence, applicable only to the Souls in Purgatory, is granted to the faithful, who visit a cemetery and pray, even if only mentally, for the departed.

The indulgence is plenary each day from November 1-8; The plenary indulgence is earned under the usual conditions: Going to Confession, receiving Holy Communion and praying for the Pope's intentions (usually one Our Father and the Creed or Hail Mary).

Confessions

Confessions on Saturday evenings at 6.00pm. After Mass on the Thursday before the First Friday. A priest will be available after Mass on the weekdays if a parishioner wishes to celebrate the sacrament.
