1 November – All Saints Day

All Saints' Day, also known as the Feast or Solemnity of All Saints, is celebrated every year on 1 November. On this day, which is a Holy Day of Obligation, we honour all of the Saints and ask them to pray for us. Mass on All Saints Day - Vigil Mass on Tues 31st at 7.00pm. Mass on All Saints Day Wed 1st of November at 10.00am

2 November – All Souls' Day

All Souls' Day or more formally 'the Commemoration of the Faithful Departed' is a solemn celebration commemorating all of those who have died and is observed on Thursday 2 November. Mass on All Souls Day at 10.00am and 7.00pm. An indulgence, applicable only to the Souls in Purgatory, is granted to the faithful, who visit a cemetery and pray, even if only mentally, for the departed. The indulgence is plenary each day from November 1-8; The plenary indulgence is earned under the usual conditions: Going to Confession, receiving Holy Communion and praying for the Pope's intentions (usually one Our Father and the Creed or Hail Mary).

Prayers for all who are buried in our parish graveyards will take place this Sunday 5th of November beginning at St Mary's graveyard at 2.00pm, the Old Graveyard at 2.20pm and Reilig Íde Naofa at 3.00pm.

Church Charitable Donation Scheme

At this time of year many parishioners who participate in the Tax Rebate Scheme are receiving a new Enduring Certificate CHY3 for signing, which will be valid for five years. Parishioners who contribute a minimum of €250 to the parish in a year and who pay tax can participate at no extra cost and the parish will benefit.
