#### 1 November – All Saints Day

All Saints' Day, also known as the Feast or Solemnity of All Saints, is celebrated every year on 1 November. On this day, which is a Holy Day of Obligation, we honour all of the Saints and ask them to pray for us. Mass on All Saints Day -Vigil Mass on Tues 31st at 7.00pm. Mass on All Saints Day Wed 1st of November at 10.00am

# 2 November – All Souls' Day

All Souls' Day or more formally 'the Commemoration of the Faithful Departed' is a solemn celebration commemorating all of those who have died and is observed on Thursday 2 November. Mass on All Souls Day at 10.00am and 7.00pm. An indulgence, applicable only to the Souls in Purgatory, is granted to the faithful, who visit a cemetery and pray, even if only mentally, for the departed. The indulgence is plenary each day from November 1-8; The plenary indulgence is earned under the usual conditions: Going to Confession, receiving Holy Communion and praying for the Pope's intentions (usually one Our Father and the Creed or Hail Mary).

### Church Charitable Donation Scheme

At this time of year many parishioners who participate in the Tax Rebate Scheme are receiving a new Enduring Certificate CHY3 for signing, which will be valid for five years. Parishioners who contribute a minimum of €250 to the parish in a year and who pay tax can participate at no extra cost and the parish will benefit.
