Preparing for Confirmation

On the 15th of May, Bishop Brendan Leahy will visit the parish to administer the Sacrament of Confirmation. Since September the children have been preparing enthusiastically with their teachers in school and have participated in the parish programme 'You shall be my Witness'. The children have also has attended a programme designed by the Catholic Church on healthy life choices, dealing with drugs, alcohol and the use of social media. This programme was delivered in Coláiste Íde agus Iosef, by the transition year students who were trained to give the programme by Mr. Darren Butler the National Coordinator of the programme.

Confirmation marks a time when young people are moving on from childhood to the teenage years. For many parents it is a time of some anxiety: what pressures will the teenage years bring? How will they cope? Confirmation offers young people an opportunity to think about serious choices that are facing them-choices about values, choices about lifestyle and of course choices about faith.

As we make our final preparations for the celebration of Confirmation, a meeting of parents will take place on **MONDAY 30TH OF APRIL** at 7.30p.m. in Coláiste Íde agus Iosef. Darren Butler, coordinator of the Healthy Life Choices Initiative will address the meeting along with some of the Transition Year Students who worked with the Confirmation Classes. We will also look at all that needs to be in place for Confirmation on the 15th of May. We look forward to welcoming all parents of sixth class.

A Word from Pope Francis

Pope Francis has sent an important message to young people about the search for vocation.

In the letter, divided into four sections, the Holy Father asks youth not to allow fear control their lives. He says this fear can be that of not being loved, being unable to find work or of God asking too much of them. The Pope urges them to broaden their horizons and not waste these years, before also giving them this advice:

"Do not allow the spark of youth to be extinguished in the darkness of a closed room in which the only window to the outside world is a computer and smartphone. Open wide the doors of your life! May your time and space be filled with meaningful relationships, real people, with whom to share your authentic and concrete experiences of daily life. Pope Francis suggests they have the bravery to live in the present, the "here and now." In fact, he assures them he wants the Church to have "important responsibilities to be given to you."

Thus, the Pope concludes with the advice "that you may be prepared to take on these responsibilities."

Youth Ministry Training

Aoife and Stephane are well known and have been involved in Youth Ministry in the parish for many years and will be developing new ways of involving young people in the life of the parish.
