

World Communication Day - Sunday 29th May 'Listening with the ear of the heart'

Archbishop Eamon Martin has welcomed this year's World Communications Day message which has just been published by Pope Francis. Archbishop Martin said, "I warmly welcome Pope Francis' 2022 World Communications Day message, which emphasises the importance of listening. This year's message,

Listening with the ear of the heart, is an invitation to reflect on how listening involves more than simply the sense of hearing. True listening is a foundation of genuine relationships and is foundational to the relationship between God and humanity.

"In his message Pope Francis notes that many people 'are quickly losing the ability to listen to one another, while at the same time listening is undergoing new developments, especially due to new forms of communicating.'

In his message Pope Francis says, 'The most important task in pastoral activity is the 'apostolate of the ear' – to listen before speaking, as the Apostle James exhorts, 'Let every man be quick to hear, slow to speak' (1:19). Freely giving some of our own time to listen to people is the first act of charity. Archbishop Martin concluded, I invite people across Ireland to read, reflect and listen to the Holy Father's words."
