Lead me and guide me, precious Lord,

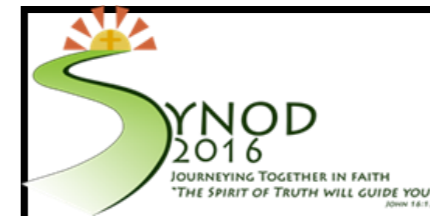
For I need your presence still...

**Diocesan Synod Update**

The first diocesan synod in over 60 years was held in the diocese of Limerick last April. In the months following on from the synod,

a working group comprised of priests, religious and laity have been drafting a Pastoral plan, so that the proposals approved by the Synod will be implemented right across the diocese. Delegates who attended the Synod in April were invited to review the proposed plan at a special meeting held in Limerick on Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> October. On Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> October the draft plan was also presented to representatives of Pastoral Councils from across the diocese. After the consultation process is complete the plan will be finalised and sent to the relevant congregation in Rome for approval. Once approved it will be published by Bishop Leahy and the work of implementing the plan will begin immediately .
