New Parish Structures – Pastoral Area

Under the new Pastoral Area structure in the Diocese of Limerick, Fr Denis Mullane and Fr Tony Mullins along with Fr Willie Russell will be looking after the pastoral needs of the people of the Pastoral Area. The local Pastoral Area of parishes includes the parishes of Abbeyfeale, Athea, Tournafulla, Mountcollins and Templeglantine. The Priests in the Pastoral Area work as a team and are no longer Parish Priests of individual parishes but are now *Co-Parish Priests* of the Area, that is, we will no longer have one single Parish Priest per parish but several priests working in all of the parishes that are linked together in the Pastoral Area. The 60 parishes in the diocese have been divided into 16 Pastoral Areas.

The priests of the Pastoral Area are assisted in the overall running of the five churches in the Pastoral Area by the Pastoral Area Council. The Pastoral Area Council is comprised of representative of the five churches in the area along with the priests of the area. Each parish will continue to have its own smaller working group (a parish pastoral co-ordinating group).

The priests of the area are supported in their work by many voluntary lay people who assist in a variety of ministries in the church and in the parish community. Fr Tony, Fr Willie and Fr Denis welcome the involvement of parishioners in the faith life of the parish and encourage more parishioners to get involved in different aspects of parish life. Working together we can help to maintain a vibrant faith community in this area of our diocese. We wish Fr Russel every blessing and success as he begins his ministry in this Pastoral Area.
