Catholic Schools Week 18th to the 24th January 2026 Catholic Schools – Normal Lives, Called to Holiness

“Holiness does not mean performing extraordinary things, but doing ordinary things with love and faith.”

• *Pope Francis on Blessed Carlo Acutis-*

Catholic Schools Week 2026 celebrates the extraordinary call to holiness in the midst of ordinary life. Inspired by Pope Francis's reflection on Blessed Carlo Acutis—soon to be canonised as the first millennial saint—this year's theme invites pupils, teachers, families, and parishes to explore the call to holiness as something both universal and accessible. Holiness is not for a few, but for all; not reserved for religious professionals or mystics, but for every student, teacher, parent, (and grandparent!) living each day in friendship with Jesus Christ. Catholic schools exist to form individuals who know that their lives have a purpose and a calling. This year's theme, “Normal Lives, Called to Holiness,” resonates with the central conviction that education is a path not only to knowledge and maturity but to sainthood. “Each of us is called to be holy by living our lives with love and by bearing witness in everything we do.”

Week of Prayer for Christian Unity from 18 to 25 January 2026 – One Body One Spirit This year's theme reminds us that the call to unity is a call to work for peace for all people everywhere. This ecumenical celebration provides an opportunity to focus our prayers on Christian unity and to know that we are joining with international siblings in Christ. WPCU is also a great chance to speak about and experience

Christian unity personally, in your village, town or county. Each January individuals pray, and churches and ecumenical organisations celebrate the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity in a variety of ways. These include events large and small, a simple prayer meeting, an ecumenical breakfast, a prayer walk, speaker events, online prayer relays, preaching swaps in villages and towns, using social media to share online reflections and prayers from church leaders as well as joint services bringing together Christians from across the traditions in prayer and worship.
