Of Limerick Saints and Seekers is the title of a book recently published by Veritas. The book is edited by David Bracken Limerick Diocesan Archivest. In this fine publication we journey through a millennium and a half of Limerick history with scholars and scribes, poets and preachers, martyrs and missionaries and founders of churches and religious communities. Drawing from early Ireland to present day, this collection of stories details the lives of extraordinary people from a variety of faith traditions and perspectives from well known saints to unknown and unsung religious and lay people. With fascinating contributions, many from the modern people of Limerick this book illuminates the diverse richness of Limerick's story by highlighting the saints and seekers who have shaped its history.
