**Holy Week**

This weekend we begin Holy Week 2021. Unfortunately, due to the ongoing restrictions it is not possible to have parishioners attend the ceremonies. We will continue to broadcast all our ceremonies online. Despite the restrictions we encourage parishioners to link into the various ceremonies. We have done a great deal of preparation to make these liturgies as meaningful as possible. We invite you and your family to join us through the internet service. A schedule of ceremonies is included in this newsletter. The schedule is also up on our parish website [www.abbeyfealeparish.ie](http://www.abbeyfealeparish.ie) and throughout Holy Week we will remind people through Facebook each day of what is happening and at what time. This year the diocese is putting on a number of ceremonies online and we have included the dates, times and links. Here in the parish we will have a special Service on 'The Gifts of the Cross' on Tuesday evening at 7.00pm. This will be a special Service of Prayer, Reflection and Music for Holy Week. The times of the other ceremonies are listed below.

This coming Sunday is Palm Sunday and marks the beginning of Holy Week.

We invite you in whatever way possible to keep this week sacred. We are all busy in our own lives with so many things to do and so many things to worry about. Perhaps this week we can take some time to reflect on our faith and the significant role it plays in our lives. These days we hear much talk about wellbeing. For people of faith the greatest source of wellbeing is found in the person of Jesus Christ.

**Sacred Space**

We encourage parishioners to create a sacred space in your homes during Holy Week. This could be located on a little table, or a window ledge. In your sacred space place, a white cloth, some palm, a little dish of water, a small towel, a crucifix and a candle.

These are the sacred symbols of Holy Week. They will help you to focus on the various ceremonies as we journey through the week.

**Distribution of Palm**

Palm blessed at Mass on Palm Sunday will be available at the Blessed Sacrament Church from 12 noon to 2.00pm on Sunday. This is also an opportunity for parishioners to give in some weekly offerings for the ongoing maintenance of the Church.

**Distribution of Easter Water**

Easter water blessed at the Easter Vigil will be available in little bottles on Easter Sunday from 12noon to 2.00pm.

**Holy Week Resources**

**Trocaire:**

The Trocaire Lenten campaign provides us with an opportunity to reach out in support to those who are most in need in the world, enabling us to fulfil one of our Lenten observances to help the poor. I know you will be generous in your donations to this year's campaign. Trocaire chief executive Caoimhe de Barra said that "Lent is the engine that keeps our programmes going throughout the year. The public in Ireland always rally behind our campaign. While this year will be different, we hope the public will continue to support our life-saving work overseas." While boxes are still available to be picked-up at churches nationwide, there are up to 50 per cent fewer boxes in circulation.

Trocaire Boxes in Abbeyfeale parish can be handed in on Good Friday between 4pm to 7pm. We suggest that where possible that people make their donation in notes rather than coin. If you are writing a cheque make it payable to Trocaire or make your donation directly to Trocaire.

**Tuesday 30th March** 'Gifts from the Cross' – A Reflective Prayer Service through Music, Song and Scripture. The Service will begin at 7.00pm.

**Holy Thursday 1st of April**

Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7.00pm followed by a period of quiet prayer.

**Good Friday 2nd of April**

**3.00pm** Celebration of the Lord's Passion

**8.00pm** Stations of the Cross

The main Church building will be open on Good Friday after the 3.00pm ceremony to allow parishioners to venerate the Cross. This year because of the restrictions parishioners can venerate the Cross by making a reverent bow before the Cross, spend a little time in prayer and then return home. The Church will be open from 4.00p.m. to 7.00p.m.

Parishioners visiting the Church are advised to observe social distancing at all times.

Blessings of Easter Baskets in the car park at 12noon. Families are asked to remain in their cars for the blessing. Please park on the grotto side of the church car park.
